"Maybe You Need a New Grid"

Dr. Ian Fair, one of my favorite NT profs at ACU, spoke often about the "grid" through which we see things in life or through which we view a particular text of Scripture. The "grid" is the lens, or the filter (composed of your experiences or observations, etc.) that you use to evaluate any experience. It "shapes" or determines how you will see things, such as how you'll view your new year. If the grid you're using isn't the right one, then you may be in for a less productive or enjoyable year, or at least, not have as positive an outlook as someone who looks through a different grid.

Jesus told his listeners in Luke 11 that if their perspective was wholesome and healthy because of filling their lives with him, their outlook would be bright (cf. 11:34-36). However the opposite would also be true without his light as their lens or grid. My prayer for all of us is that the lenses by which we evaluate our world are the Lord's life and the truth of His Word! Those lenses will ensure 20/20 vision!

Shannon McGee, Megan Odiorne's father, has not been doing well lately. He is having heart issues and feeling weak.

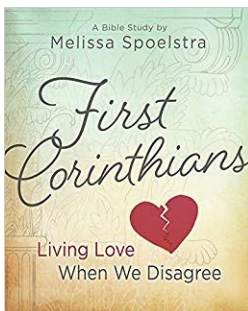

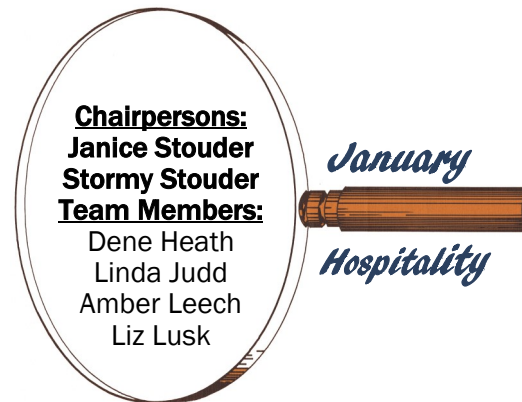
